LION SANDS | CHALKLEY TREEHOUSE

Over the years the Chalkley Treehouse has evolved from a rustic retreat, built by Lion Sands founder, Guy Aubrey Chalkley to a lavish and exclusive hideaway raised above the sands scenic landscape. The treehouse is located in Lion Sands Sabi Sand and for guests staying at Ivory Lodge or River Lodge it can be booked in conjunction with your accommodation. Get ready for your overnight adventure, pack a small bag with your essentials and drive 10 minutes from the lodge to your secluded section of the sands - Enjoy a truly unique safari adventure under the African starlit skies.

MARATABA | THABAMETSI TREEHOUSE

This stylish, eco-friendly treehouse getaway has arguably one of the best Waterberg wilderness views in the country, built in the big-five Marataba Game Reserve, which forms part of the UNESCO Waterberg biosphere. The treehouse itself is an architectural masterpiece, built using local materials, with each element from the design to the decor taking inspiration from the natural world. Woven around a Weeping Boer-Bean tree and encircled by the Waterberg Mountain Range, the Thabametsi Treehouse offers a romantic spot to share sundowners and tapas before the golden glow gives way to a star-strewn sky. Guests staying at Mountain Lodge can book the treehouse in conjunction with your accommodation. Fall asleep to the sounds of the wild, surrounded by stars.

AFRICA ON FOOT | TREEHOUSE

Overlooking the distant Drakensberg Mountains and the bustling bushveld below, the treehouse is perfect for fearless romantics and wilderness enthusiasts. Entwined in iconic marula trees, there are two platforms to this treehouse escape, a game viewing and seating level and a 180 degree view room on the upper level. At the end of the day your guide will escort you to the treehouse, where you will spend the night listening to the Klaserie crescendo before falling asleep in your open-air hideout.
