XaXaBa Island | Botswana

Xaxaba Mobile Camp is run by Afrika Ecco Safaris from the local Xaxaba community. It is located on a private island deep within the heart of the Okavango Delta, a world-heritage site renowned for its abundance of wildlife. The safari experience is all encompassing in that it offers the best of both land and water game viewing where guests can indulge in mokoro trips, boating, fishing and walking safaris. The traditional dug-out wooden canoe is utilized in the Okavango Delta and silently glides through the waterways, guides take guests closer to nature and to the wildlife in the Delta than ever before.

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Taita Falcon | ZAMBIA

Nestled above the Zambezi River, overlooking its winding waters and the dramatic cliffs of the Batoka Gorge lies Taita Falcon Lodge. This wilderness retreat is located in the heart of Zambia, downriver from the mighty Victoria Falls. The lodge itself was designed to showcase the dramatic views that surround it. With its vast viewing platform, open-air bar and lounge perched over the sheer cliffs, it's the perfect place to sit and take in Zambia's scenic vistas. Taita is an ideal base to explore the falls and experience the many activities offered in the area, suiting everyone from adventure seekers to luxury lovers.

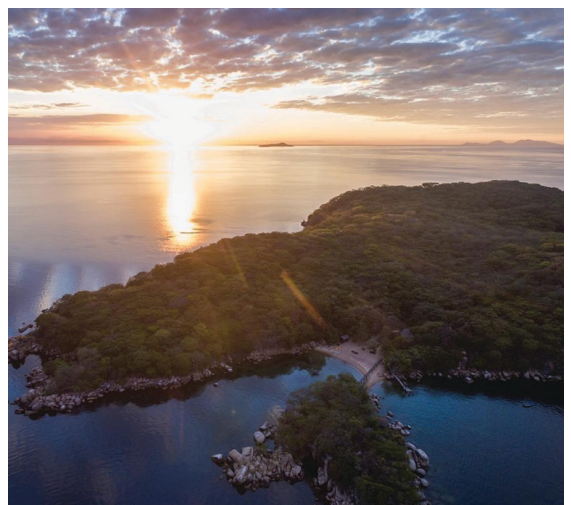
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Mumbo Island | MALAWI

Located on a pristine island in Lake Malawi National Park, with its crystal clear waters and spectacular views, Mumbo offers a lake side retreat in the heart of Malawi. The surrounding waters also have some of the best freshwater scuba diving in the world. The island lies 10km north-west of Cape Maclear. There are five secluded lake view chalets perched on the rocks and shaded by lush foliage. A hammock provides a comfortable spot to take in the idyllic lake view. Activities vary from lazing in a hammock to snorkeling, diving, swimming, kayaking, walking and bird watching. Guests also have the option of boating or paddling to explore the granitic islands of the Lake. Mumbo Island is an ideal destination for those seeking an eco-friendly getaway on a secluded and scenic island in Africa.

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
